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## HUSBAND THROWN OUT OF HOUSE FOR SIGNING UP WIFE AND HIM

### FOR TWO BACK TO BACK MARATHONS

**EXCLUSIVE:** Police were called to the home of Keith and Lynn Benninghoff last night after neighbors complained of loud shouting and yelling coming from inside the residence. Upon arrival they found Keith on the front lawn lying under a pile of clothing while an irate Lynn shouted and threw his personal items at him from the second floor.

Apparently the argument started after Keith informed Lynn that he had signed them both up for not one, but two marathons, back to back this year. The first one is on October 25<sup>th</sup> in Washington DC and the second, a month later on November 22<sup>nd</sup> in Philadelphia PA. Keith is signed up to run both full marathons while Lynn is signed up for the full Washington 26.2 mile run followed by the Philadelphia 13.1 mile half marathon.

Once the police left the premises I, “John Runaholic”, was able to obtain an exclusive interview with both of them:

**Lynn** “I don’t care if he is going through a midlife crisis. I think he is really trying to kill me. I actually checked my life insurance to make sure he did not increase it recently. Two marathons back to back – who does he think I am? Wonder Woman?! I have officially banished him from the house till he makes amends.”

**Keith** “Boy! She may not be Wonder Woman but she can sure throw a punch like her. Lynn says that in order for Keith to make it back in the house they must use their energy with the Marathons to again raise money for the Arc of Lancaster County, **a wonderful nonprofit organization dedicated to helping individuals of all ages with intellectual disabilities and their families.** Keith and Lynn are starting this pledge drive with \$100.00 and another \$100.00 if Keith does not qualify for the Boston Marathon in either race. Keith’s qualifying time for the Boston marathon is 3 hrs and 30 minutes or less, and that is 33 minutes faster than last year’s Philadelphia marathon. They are also pledging another \$50.00 if their combined times for both marathons is not under 14 hrs and 10 minutes. Neither task is easy since this is only their second and third marathons and as Lynn yelled before tossing Keith out the front door –

“WE AIN’T GETTIN ANY YOUNGER”.
