<b>Single:</b>	<b>\$100-199</b>	supports (dis)Ability Awareness Training for 200 elementary school kids*
<b>Double:</b>	<b>\$200-299</b>	supports one monthly meeting of SIBSHOP support group for kids, ages 8-12*
<b>Triple:</b>	<b>\$300-399</b>	supports one year of advocacy for one individual with intellectual disabilities*
<b>Home Run:</b>	<b>\$500-999</b>	supports one year of advocacy for two or three individuals & families
<b>Grand Slam:</b>	<b>\$1000 and up</b>	supports one year of advocacy for more than three individuals & families

\*Last year The Arc of Lancaster County:

- Presented (dis)Ability Awareness Training to over 1700 elementary students, helping them understand it's OK to be friends with their peers who have disabilities
- Coordinated monthly SIBSHOP meetings over eight months for brothers and sisters of kids with disabilities, giving the sibs a "safe place" to vent their fears and frustrations and to share the good times, too
- Supported with advocacy services over 200 individuals with intellectual disabilities and their families as they had to make decisions about school and basic life choices like where to live, work, play and worship
